

Guillot Bourne

Being a field nursery, Guillot Bourne dig and ship trees from October until April. On one side during this time of the year the weather is permitting better and safer shipping for the trees and on the other side the growing is best once the tree is planted in its final location.

Some planting take place outside of this period. In order to provide their customers with the best quality, they have developed two additional products. They can either offer the transplantation of the trees during fall or winter in an air-pot system for shipping after April. This system allows them to keep the trees well watered up to the point of shipping and in this way to minimize the transplantation's impact. Or they can offer a planting into made to measure pots and pre-culture the plants at their nursery for shipping whenever the construction site is ready for the delivery of the trees in their pots.

This system called Gegebac Hf @ is a unique system of made to measure pots, plants and substrate to ensure the needs of every unique project. The substrate is 100% mineral with a weight of 600kg per m³ with a reserve of water, an overflow and a gauge. The mineral substrate has the particularity to stay intact for the roots to grow up to 15 years after plantation.
